Consequently, he/she monitors complex and/or repetitive defects troubleshooting, perform regular aircraft visits for conditions checks, and acts as technical representative for the CAMO for line maintenance at homebase. He/she may also be assigned sporadically to technical representative role for base maintenance checks. He/ she plays a pivotal role in ensuring the operational reliability of the airline's fleet by providing expert technical guidance and coordination. This role involves management of aircraft recovery when in AOG (Aircraft on Ground) situations, analysing technical defects, modificaitons and collaborating across various departments to enhance operational efficiency and technical reliability.  |
